After consideration of a report from the Joint Committee, in which this item was referred back to the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners, a motion was made to defer further

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
consideration of this request to the Board's March agenda. The motion was adopted without objection.

After consideration of a report from the Joint Committee, a motion was made to adopt the amended standard language as proposed by the Joint Committee: The NP or PA must directly observe no less than 3 procedures by a fully trained physician; the NP or PA must perform 20 CVL insertions with no less than 10 under direct supervision by a physician. The remaining 10 procedures may be supervised by either a previously certified NP or PA; CVL removal may not be performed in a simulation laboratory; all procedures performed during the training protocol, as well as those independently performed after certification, should be recorded in the electronic health record for tracking the frequency of the procedure performance and for complication occurrence; and ongoing proficiency should be demonstrated and documented every 6 months with the requirement that 10 procedures be performed. The six month documentation should be kept on file at the facility. The motion was adopted without objection.

Critical Care Specialty Protocol Skills: CVL removal: percutaneous and tunneled The Credentials Committee recommended that this skill be added to the Critical Care Specialty Protocol. The motion was adopted without objection.

After consideration and approval of a report from the Joint Committee, standard


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language for central venous line removal, percutaneous and tunneled, shall include the following: ten initial procedures must be documented after receiving approval to train; five procedures are required for annual maintenance; training and maintenance may not be performed in a simulation lab; supervised practice must be submitted within one year for approval or the approval to train will lapse; and this skill will only be considered for practitioners who have previously been approved or are requesting to train to place central venous line, internal jugular and femoral. The motion was adopted without objection.

Statewide criteria for otolaryngology procedure requests by mid-level providers The Credentials Committee recommended deferring consideration of this item pending a report from Joint Committee. The motion was adopted without objection.

After consideration of a report from the Joint Committee, a motion was made to approve the following amendment to the initial and supervised practice requirements: the CRNP or PA must have observed no less than 150 each of the requested procedure(s) (including normal/abnormal tissue distinction), before requesting to train to perform the procedure(s). The CRNP or PA will perform and document no less than 25 procedures yearly to maintain certification. The motion was adopted without objection.

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




