Call to Order: 11:50 a.m.

With prior notice given in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act, and with a quorum of fifteen members present, Board Chairman Mark H. LeQuire, M.D., convened the public portion of the meeting of the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners.

Executive Director's Report

Executive Director Sarah H. Moore reported on the license and registration renewals that began October 1, 2019, including the new option of e-checks for payment of the licensing fees and recognizing staff members for their work in the renewal process.

Director Moore gave a report on the recently formed consultant work groups and encouraged Board Members to commit to serve in a designated area if they had not already done so.

Ashley Hamlett, Licensing Director, and Tiffany Seamon, Licensing Supervisor, will travel to the North Carolina Medical Board to review licensing processes and Director Moore will attend an Executive Director Workshop hosted by the Administrators in Medicine in November.

Director Moore introduced Suzanne Lazenby, R.N., and Marshika Watkins, who are recent hires in the collaborative practice department.

MINUTES

Public Minutes of September 18, 2019 The Credentials Committee recommended that the Public Minutes of September 18, 2019, be approved. The motion was adopted without objection.

CURRENT BUSINESS

Proposed Administrative Rules

Administrative Rules 540-X-8-.06 and .20 – Authorization for Practice as a Certified Nurse Practitioner / Certified Nurse Midwife The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rules 540-X-8-.06 and .20 be approved for publication for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*. The motion was adopted without objection.

ACSC Requirement – Exclusion of VA Physicians The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rules be drafted that would exclude physicians working only in the Veterans Administration system from the Alabama Controlled Substances Certificate requirement. The motion was adopted without objection.

CME – Anesthesiologist Assistants After consideration of correspondence from the Foundation for Advancement of Anesthesia Care Team (FAACT), the Credentials Committee recommended that, only for the purpose of meeting the continuing medical education requirement for the renewal of an Anesthesiologist Assistant license, rules be drafted that would deem continuing medical education accredited by FAACT to be the equivalent of AMA PRA Category 1. The motion was adopted without objection.

Definition of Palliative Care The Credentials Committee recommended deferring for a discussion by the full Board.

After consideration by the full Board of current standard language for the prescribing of long-acting controlled substances under a Limited Purpose Special Permit, a motion was made by Michael T. Flanagan, M.D., and was seconded by Gregory W. Ayers, M.D., to amend the Limited Purpose Special Permit standard language for long-acting schedule II controlled

substances to exclude the prescribing of long-acting controlled substances to palliative care patients for chronic pain or illness or long-term medical therapies. The prescribing of long-acting controlled substances by a certified registered nurse practitioner, a certified nurse midwife, or a physician assistant shall be limited to hospice, palliative care within hospice, nursing home and oncology patients only. The motion was adopted without objection.

Tri-Regulator Symposium Report – Dr. O’Neill and Dr. Owens The Credentials Committee recommended that the report made by Patrick J. O’Neill, M.D. be deferred to the full Board.

After consideration by the full Board, the report given by Dr. O’Neill was received as information.




