

STATE BOARDS THAT HAVE A SPECIAL PURPOSE LICENSE
OR TELEMEDICINE LICENSE

The following states have a statute that recognizes special purpose or telemedicine licenses. Under our Special Purpose License statute, Ala. Code § 34-24-507, we can only issue a COQ for a Special Purpose License to a doctor whose principal practice location and license to practice is located in a state that that recognizes special purpose or telemedicine licenses.
