CURRENT BUSINESS

Alabama Physician Health Program - License Renewal Question After consideration of a request from the Alabama Physician Wellness Committee, the Credentials Committee recommended the Board not approve a change to the current renewal question regarding psychiatric treatment. The Committee further recommends inviting Dr. Skipper to meet with the Committee at a later date to further address this issue. The motion was adopted.

Botox Seminars After consideration of correspondence from Jonathan Munoz, M.D., the Credentials Committee recommended providing Dr. Munoz' letter to the Alabama Board of Nursing and recommended suggesting that the Board of Nursing post a notice

on their website that nurses and nurse practitioners can not administer Botox, Restalyn, or Collagen in the State of Alabama. Further recommendation was made to include this information in the ABME newsletter. The motion was adopted.

<u>Declaratory Ruling</u> The Credentials Committee recommended approval of the Declaratory Ruling concerning the application of § 34-24-360(10). The motion was adopted.

Fee Increase The Credentials Committee recommended that a recommendation be made to the Medical Licensure Commission to increase the annual license renewal fee from \$200 to \$300. The Committee further recommended amending Administrative Rule 540-X-4-.01 to increase the fee for the Alabama Controlled Substance Certificate (ACSC) from \$100 to \$140. The total fee for the ACSC will be \$150, to include the mandated \$10 Prescription Monitoring Database fee. The motion was adopted.

<u>University of Health Sciences, Antigua</u> After consideration of information which indicates the University of Health Sciences, Antigua, (UHSA) confers medical degrees to candidates based on online course work and transfer credits from health profession programs which do not confer the MD or DO degree, the Credentials Committee recommended the addition of the University of Health Sciences, Antigua, to the Board's list of unapproved medical schools based on practices by the UHSA, which are inconsistent with quality medical education, by amending Rule 540-X-3-.02 on an emergency basis and also filing the rule for public comment. The motion was adopted.
