Request Clarification regarding Nurse Practitioner Weight Loss Clinic The Credentials Committee recommended responding to Mr. Bell that the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners is the authority that regulates physicians and that the Alabama Board of Nursing has no regulatory authority over physicians. The motion was adopted.

Request for FTE Exemption The Credentials Committee recommended denying the request for an FTE exemption. The motion was adopted.

Request for Board Opinion The Credentials Committee recommended that the Board adopt the opinion that, in regards to Administrative Rules 540-X-8-.04(1)(b) and 540-X-8-.18(1)(b), the practice of medicine is defined as practicing with an active, unrestricted medical license and the practice of medicine includes that portion of post-graduate training completed after receipt of an, unrestricted medical license. It is the Board's opinion that a covering physician's licensure requirement is the same as required of a collaborating physician. The motion was adopted.

Deborah Jeter, PA / R. Jobe Fix, M.D. - Closing and repairing abdominal donor site by

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PA The Credentials Committee recommended approval for PA Jeter, formerly designated as a Surgeon Assistant, to close and repair abdominal donor sites only with Dr. Fix physically present and scrubbed for the procedure. The Committee's recommendation is based upon the PA and physician's registration having been in place prior to, and having remained in place since, the Board's 1998 Administrative Rule amendment in which Surgeon Assistants were converted to Physician Assistants. The Committee further recommended notifying PAs and physicians, with similar registrations, of this Board decision. The motion was adopted.

<u>Donnie Willoughby, PA / Carlton Savory, M.D. - Letter of clarification</u> The Credentials Committee recommended notifying Dr. Savory that PA Willoughby is ineligible to apply for an Alabama PA license due to statutory requirements. The motion was adopted.

RN to Dictate Discharge Summary - The Credentials Committee recommended approval for an RN to dictate the discharge summary from information already documented in the record. The expectation of the Board is that the discharge summary will include all pertinent information required by physicians providing subsequent care, including admitting diagnosis, discharge diagnosis, discharge medications, follow-up plans and an appropriately detailed narrative of the patient's hospital course. The dictated discharge summary shall be reviewed and signed by the physician who shall accept full responsibility for the summary. The motion was adopted.

Pediatric Acute Care Nurse Practitioner - Removal of intra-luminal obstructive material

The Board recommended approval for Pediatric Acute Care Nurse Practitioners, with preapproved physician protocol and by physician order only, to remove intra-luminal
obstructive material through the catheter lumen by use of thrombolytic agents. The motion

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was adopted.

Joint Committee on Advanced Practice Nursing

Joint Committee Meeting - July 15, 2008 The Credentials Committee recommended deferring to the full Board for an oral report to be presented by Dr. Smith. The Board recommended the oral report presented by Dr. Smith be received as information and the recommendations of the Joint Committee be approved. The motion was adopted. Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.28ER, Prescriptions and Medication Orders - Physician Assistant The Credentials Committee recommended amending Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.28 by deleting subparagraph (8) in its entirety and filing the rule for publication for public comment in the Administrative Monthly. The Committee further recommended that staff draft proposed language allowing mid-level practitioners to write a verbal order for controlled substances for hospitalized patients and nursing home patients. The motion was adopted.

Administrative Rule 540-X-14, Continuing Medical Education The Credentials Committee recommended deferring consideration to amend the continuing medical education requirements pending additional information. The motion was adopted.

Article, Performance during Internal Medicine Residency Training and Subsequent

Disciplinary Action by State Licensing Boards The Credentials Committee recommended

receiving the article as information. The motion was adopted.

<u>Fingerprint Background Check Options</u> After consideration of a proposal for provision of fingerprint card processing services, the Credentials Committee recommended notifying Southern Detention Technologies, Inc., the Board declines the use of their services at this time. The motion was adopted.

Fee for Criminal History Background Check The Credentials Committee recommended setting the criminal history background check fee in the amount of sixty-five dollars (\$65), to include a forty-nine dollar (\$49) fee required by the Alabama Bureau of Investigation and a sixteen dollar (\$16) fee for administrative costs. The motion was adopted.

Amendments to Administrative Rules - 540-X-3, Certificate of Qualification / 540-X-5, Hearings and Appeals / 540-X-6, Conduct of Hearings / 540-X-7, Assistants to Physicians

The Credentials Committee recommended adopting new and amended Administrative Rules in Chapters 540-X-3, 540-X-5, 540-X-6, and 540-X-7, as amended by the Committee, as emergency rules and filing the new and amended rules for publication for public comment in the Administrative Monthly. The motion was adopted.

Postgraduate Education Requirement for a License to Practice Medicine The Credentials Committee recommended deferring consideration of the postgraduate education requirement to allow staff to conduct further research. The motion was adopted.

Administrative Rule 540-X-8-.10, Functions and Activities of Certified Registered Nurse

Practitioners After consideration of a recommendation from the Joint Committee on

Advanced Practice Nurses, the Credentials Committee recommended approval to amend
subparagraph (5) as follows and file the rule for publication for public comment in the

Administrative Monthly: A certified registered nurse practitioner may write admission orders

for inpatients as directed by the physician and subsequent orders in accordance with

established protocols and institutional policies. The motion was adopted.
