Winifred Agard, M.D. - Seven year time limit for USMLE After consideration of correspondence from Beverly E. Boyd, M.D., regarding Dr. Agard, the Credentials Committee recommended notifying Dr. Boyd that, under current statute, Dr. Agard does not qualify for full licensure in the State of Alabama, and that Alabama does not issue interim or temporary licenses; however, Dr. Agard may qualify to apply for a limited license as a Distinguished Professor or as an employee of a state institution, if she seeks employment at a medical school or other state institution approved by the Board.

The Committee further recommended researching other state USMLE limits, and for the 2008 legislative session, considering one of the following options: 1) extend 7 year time limit, but limit the number of attempts; or, 2) retain 7 year time limit but allow Board discretion to consider specialty board certification. The Committee also recommended considering for the 2008 legislative session, limiting the total number of attempts for all steps of the USMLE. The motion was adopted.

The Credentials Committee recommended providing a copy of the Board's Statement, as amended by the Committee, to each person who submitted a comment relative to Administrative Rule 540-X-1-.16, Fees Associated with Collaborative Practice, Administrative Rule 540-X-8-.04, Qualification for Physicians in Collaborative Practice with Certified Registered Nurse Practitioner, and Administrative Rule 540-X-8-.18, Qualification for Physicians in Collaborative Practice with Certified Nurse Midwives. The motion was adopted.

Administrative Rule 540-X-4, Appendix A, Application for Controlled Substance Registration Certificate The Credentials Committee recommended that the proposed amendment to Administrative Rule 540-X-4, Appendix A, be approved for adoption. The motion was adopted.

American Society for Dermatologic Surgery - Correspondence, Re: Fraudulent Advertising The Credentials Committee recommended that the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery be informed that the Board has declined their request to adopt rules as requested by the Society. The motion was adopted.

<u>Collaborative Practice Fee as Physician Qualification</u> The Credentials Committee recommended that the correspondence with the Alabama Board of Nursing be received as information. The motion was adopted.

Medical Association of the State of Alabama (MASA) - Memo, Re: 2008 CME and 2008

Annual Session The Credentials Committee recommended approval of MASA's proposal to establish a continuing medical education program to conduct workshops regarding pain management, controlled substance diversion, and the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program. The Committee further recommended that the abuse of controlled substances in the weight loss clinic setting also be included in the CME program. The Committee recommended that at MASA's Annual Session, the Board have a physician panel, provide an overview of selected topics and have a question and answer session for attendees. The Committee recommended notifying MASA that the Board will need only a one hour session. The motion was adopted.

Pharmacists Dispensing Insulin After consideration of correspondence from the Alabama Board of Pharmacy, the Credentials Committee recommended requesting that the Board of Pharmacy ask pharmacists to recommend to patients that they obtain a proper insulin prescription when filling insulin on an emergency basis. The motion was adopted.

Board Interpretation of Laser Rules The Credentials Committee recommended that,

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hyfrecators, thermage, and cryotherapy, as these modalities currently exist, are not governed by 540-X-11, and physicians do not have to register hyfrecators, thermage, or cryotherapy when used only by the physician. The Committee recommended that physicians using the electrocautery in the office setting must be registered. The Committee further opined that radiofrequency endovascular procedures are ablative and are governed under Administrative Rule 540-X-11, and that the physician must register, but is not required to have written protocols or quality assurance since the procedure cannot be delegated. The motion was adopted.

2008 Contract for Education Services A motion was made to approve the 2008 Contract for Education Services between the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners and the Medical Association of the State of Alabama. The motion was adopted.

2008 Alabama Physician Health Program Contract A motion was made to approve the 2008 Alabama Physician Health Program Contract between the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners and the Medical Association of the State of Alabama. The motion was adopted.
